Dozens of civilians have been killed, including after the rocket attacks recently on Charkov.

More than 400,000 Ukrainians have fled abroad.

The European Union should not wait with arms crossed.




Our member organization in Ukraine "Vost Volya" welcomes Charkov's initiative to immediately apply for membership to the European Union.

After Vladimir Putin's threatening nuclear language, European support is urgently needed.

Today, 5 days after the invasion, the Russian offensive continues unabated, but negotiations between Russia and Ukraine also got started.
